SAFE HOUSEHOLD MEDICAL SHARPS DISPOSAL

What are household medical sharps?

A: Needles and lancets used at home to inject medicine into people or pets.

Why are special disposal instructions necessary?

A: State law prohibits disposing of needles and lancets in the trash. Properly disposing of sharps helps keep potentially harmful products out of the waste stream.

PROPER SHARPS DISPOSAL

- Place sharps in an approved, rigid, puncture-resistant, shatter-proof container. Containers can be obtained at the Wayland Transfer Station or purchased at your local pharmacy. Keep containers out of reach of children.
- There is no time limit for keeping containers use the container until it is nearly full and then tightly close the lid.
- Reinforce the lid with tape so sharps won't spill out.
- Dispose of the entire container at the Wayland Transfer Station.

DO NOT bring loose needles or lancets to the Transfer Station for disposal

<u>DO NOT</u> put sharps containers, loose needles, or lancets in your recycling bin, garbage, or down the toilet.

Sharps disposal is available to Wayland residents ONLY, and does not require a permit.

Sharps from businesses WILL NOT be accepted at the Transfer Station.
