

Town of Wayland, Massachusetts Scenic Roads

The Scenic Roads Bylaw can be found in the Wayland Town Code, Chapter 158, Article 5 (§158-5). The purpose of the bylaw is to maintain the rural, natural, historic and scenic character of the town's roads. Scenic Road Bylaws are permitted under Massachusetts General Law Chapter 40, section 15C. In 1974 the Town designated 18 different roads, 21 miles total, as scenic. 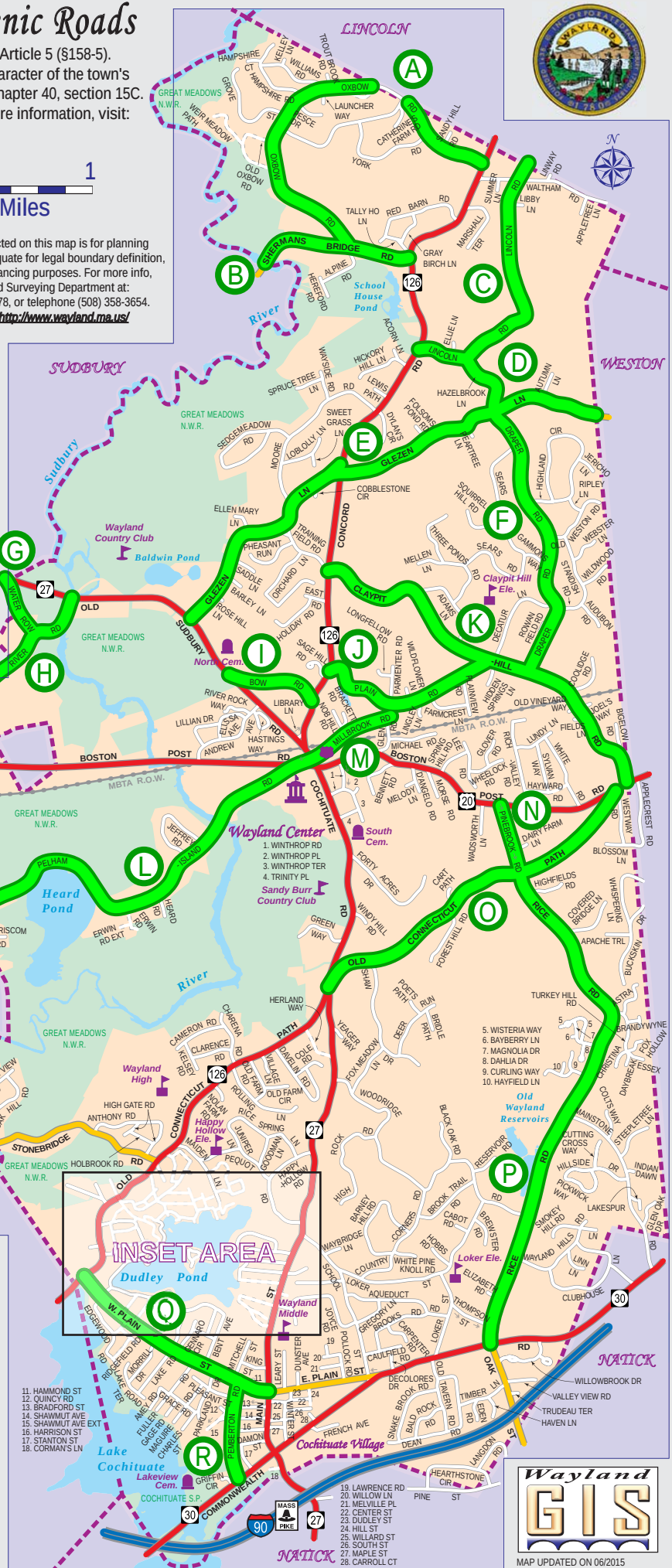
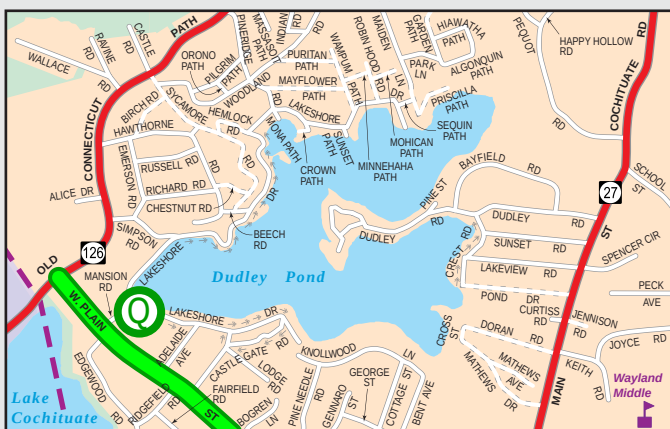
